Regarding Desealing of 114 A

Dear Ayesha,

As an elected teacher representative of GSCASH, I wish to draw your attention to the following issues:

- 1) On 12th December 2017, I received a letter from Registrar JNU, Dr Pramod Kumar seeking my presence at 10.00 am to comply with the High Court Order dated 28.11.2017 (W.P.(C) 8446/2017. It may please be noted that I had received an email on 11th evening from the Registrar's office regarding the same. I noticed however that it was ccd to people who had already tendered their resignation from GSCASH and also not forwarded to a new member who had already joined before the forceful locking of GSCASH office.
- 2) Despite the fact that I was given such short notice and this being the vacation period of the University I, wanting to follow the High Court order, downloaded the same from the High Court Website and noticed that the Registrar's communication (copy of which I am attaching) was misleading to say the least.
- 3) I therefore followed the instructions of the High court order as required
- 3) I would also like to inform you that during the process there was a breach of confidentiality of a pending GSCASH case by the ICC presiding officer .
- 4) I was also informed by the ICC presiding officer that the GSCASH email was no longer available for access and therefore I am wondering what has happened to the email communications exchanged via the official GSCASH ID prior to it being disbanded illegally by the Vice Chancellor

I feel obliged to put these matters on record.
