1. Schedule of Admission

The Schedule of Admission for the year 2017-18 in the light of previous years' Schedule of Admission and resolved to recommend minor changes in some of the dates as under:

2. There will be desynchronization in result declaration between Science and non-Science Schools in order to facilitate student admission into various programmes on time.

3. Modes of admission to M.Phil/PhD programme
Six modes of admission in M.Phil/Ph.D programmes will be there :

Through Entrance Examination

- i) M.Phil/M.Tech./Pre-Ph.D/MPH - Ph.D Integrated for candidates possessing Master's degree;
- ii) M.Phil/M.Tech.
- iii) M.Sc. - Ph.D integrated
- iv) M.Phil/M.Tech./Pre-Ph.D/MPH - Ph.D Integrated for candidates possessing JRF/UGC NET
- v) Ph.D for JRF/UGC NET holders
- vi) Ph.D for M.Phil holders or equivalent qualification.

Various fellowships holders, such as UGC/CSIR NET etc. who have passed M.Phil Programmes will go through an Entrance Test for selection before appearing in Viva Voce.

4. Entrance Test:

There will be three-stage examination pattern in JNU Entrance Examinations
Part-A: Preliminary Examination paper consisting of Research Methodology (50%) and Domain Knowledge (50%) in respective subjects/programmes. The questions will be (OMR) type.

Part-B: Descriptive-type Written Test (subject specific)

Part-C: Viva-Voce:

- Preliminary Test will be qualifying in nature and General Category candidates will require 50 percent marks to move to the Part B/C. SC/ST/PwD candidates will get 30 percent relaxation over the qualifying marks (i.e 35%) and OBC candidates will get 10 percent relaxation over the qualifying marks (i.e 45%)
- Weightage of marks in Part B (descriptive written type) will be 80 percent and Part C (Viva-voce) will be 20 percent.
- If a candidate does not secure the minimum prescribed percentage of marks in the preliminary examination, her/his papers in Part B will not be evaluated and the candidate will be ineligible for the subsequent stages of Entrance Test.
- Will adhere to national level reservation policy, as applicable.

5. Award of Deprivation Points:

The existing practice of giving deprivation points by the university to students coming from backward areas of the country will continue. As per existing practice, the deprivation points, wherever applicable, will be added to the total score of the candidates in Part B and Part C tests and coded merit lists will be drawn and forwarded to respective Schools/Centers.

6. District Quartile

As per the recommendations of the District Quartile Committee of JNU 36 more districts will be added to.

7. Intake

The intake in M.Phil/PhD programmes will be calculated as per the 2016 UGC Gazette Notification.
