Dear Colleague,

The Committee, headed by the undersigned was formed by the Competent Authority to discuss the issues related to holding the JNU Entrance Examinations in the month of December every year, in place of the current schedule. As per the discussion in the Committee, I would like to request you to give your observations on the following by 8th June 2017, Thursday. Because of the paucity of time, it may be considered urgent. The views of different Centres will be tabled in the Standing Committee Meeting:-

1. Holding of the Entrance Examinations in two parts: Part A [objective type] and Part B [descriptive type].
Please give your views whether the marks of both sections should be aggregated or whether only those who passed Part (A) of the Entrance Examination should be eligible for further evaluation of their Part (B) answer scripts.
2. The Centre may give its views on whether duration of Examinations should be curtailed to 2 hours as against the present 3 hours.
3. There is a need to evolve certain clear cut procedures and principles for preparing Question Papers of Entrance Examinations as well as evaluation of the answer scripts. The Centre may please give its views for further discussion in the Standing Committee Meeting.
4. The Committee members also emphasized the need for uploading the syllabus along with the prospectus on the University website. The Centres are thus requested to prepare their respective syllabus well in advance for the forthcoming Entrance Examinations in December 2017.

If there is no response by 8th June 2017, it will be presumed that the Centre will be agreeable to decision taken in the Standing Committee on Admissions.
