

GUIDELINES TO WORK OUT INTAKE FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-19

Dear Colleagues,


With reference to the subject cited above, the following points may be taken into consideration:

1. As per the UGC Regulations 2016, only regular faculty/Teacher can be appointed as supervisor. Thus, superannuated faculty, re-employed faculty, research scientist, part-time/ad-hoc/guest teacher(s) and faculty without Ph.D degree are not eligible to act as supervisor and, hence, may not be taken into consideration to work out intake.
2. The students who have been de-registered from the M.Phil./Ph.D. programme should not be included in the current strength of the students of the respective programme.
3. The number of students enrolled under 9(b) clause of Ph.D. Ordinance of JNU will be considered as possible vacant seat while calculating intake positions for the Academic Year, 2018-19.
4. The number of students who are in final year of the Ph.D. programmes, as per the Ordinance, will be considered as possible vacant seat while calculating intake positions for the Academic Year, 2018-19.
5. In view of the minimum period required to complete M.Phil./Ph.D. research work, as per the UGC regulations 2016 and the academic interest of the students, it is advised that the faculty who are going to retire/superannuate by June 2021 should not take new Ph.D. student(s) for guidance; and the faculty who are going to retire/superannuate by June 2020 should not be supervisors for M.Phil. students admitted in the Acad. Year, 2018-19.
6. The M.Phil./Ph.D. students registered under the faculties who have been retired/superannuated/resigned and/or are going to retire/superannuate by July 2018 should be transferred to the other faculties in due course of time. However, the number of students who are not going to submit their dissertation/thesis by July 2018, their seats will not be treated as vacant.
7. The number of students who are registered in 3rd Semester of M.Phil. (integrated M.Phil./Ph.D. Programme) and students who are registered under provisional Ph.D. will be considered as continuing students of integrated M.Phil./Ph.D. Programmes for the purpose of calculation of intake for the Ph.D. Programme for the Acad. Year, 2018-19.

8. The number of students who are registered in M.Phil. Programme for the Academic Year, 2017-18, in the Monsoon Semester 2017 and doing course work will be considered as continuing students of M.Phil. Programme for the purpose of calculation of intake for M.Phil. Programme for the Academic Year, 2018-19.
9. The M.Phil./Ph.D. students to whom supervisors are yet to be allotted may be tentatively adjusted against the faculties who have vacancies to enable the Admission Branch to decide the number of intake.
10. The faculty members who have excess number of students, as per UGC Regulation 2016, may continue with the present number of students as supervisor. However, he/she can take new intake only after the number comes down to the limit prescribed in the UGC Regulation 2016.
11. The details may be provided in the attached format.

In view of the above, it is requested to kindly draw the intake of your Centre/School as per the UGC Regulation 2016 and the guidelines given above. It is also requested to kindly send the same to the Assistant Registrar (Evaluation) (E-mail: dr_eval@mail.jnu.ac.in) in the attached format latest by 24th August, 2017 (Thursday).
