Minutes of the meeting held on 18th August, 2017 at 11.30 am in the Committee Room No. 225 with the Deans of the Schools and Chairpersons of the Special Centres with respect to discuss the issues regarding JNU EE to be held in December for the Academic Year 2018-19.

In addition to the Deans/Chairpersons of Special Centres, Dr. Krishnendra Meena, SIS, Shri M. K. Pachauri, Deputy Registrar, Dr. Sajjan Singh, Assistant Registrar (Evaluation), Shri S. Venkat, System Analyst and Ms. Rajni Vaid, P.S. to DoA were also present in the meeting.

At the outset, Rector-I welcomed all the Deans and Chairpersons of Special Centres and requested Director of Admissions to conduct the meeting. Director of Admissions briefed the members about the decisions taken in the last meeting. The minutes of the last meeting and the tentative School wise students enrolled to workout intake as per the data available with the CIS, were circulated to the members. Further, Director of Admissions said that the "meeting is called to discuss the key issues/problems being faced by the Admission Branch" and apprised the members of the need for collective efforts to conduct JNU EE, 2018-19, in December, 2017.

The following agenda points were discussed in the meeting :

1. Intake for the academic session, 2018-19.
2. Prospectus and syllabus for JNU EE, 2018-19
3. Delinking of M. Phil./Ph. D.
4. Master Degree as minimum qualification for M. Phil. and Ph. D. Programmes.

After detailed deliberations, the following decisions/recommendations were adopted :

1. Director of Admissions apprised the members that the guidelines to work out intake for the Academic Year, 2018-19 and list of registered M.Phil./Ph.D. students to update the same have been sent to all the Centre/School office. All members were requested to provide the required details and intake by the given dates.
2. Director of Admissions also apprised that the information sought by the DoA office regarding the Syllabus and Prospectus for the academic session, 2018-19 are not received yet from some Centres/Schools and, requested the members for follow up action at the Deans/Chairpersons level.
3. The provisions of UGC Regulations 2016 on the intake was discussed in detail. To get higher intake in M.Phil./Ph.D. Courses, it was suggested not to continue with the existing integrated M.Phil./Ph.D. Programmes and delink the same. The Deans/Chairpersons of Special Centres, after detailed deliberations with the Centres of the concerned School, should report their respective decisions at the next meeting of the Standing Committee on Admissions.
4. In compliance to the clarification given by the UGC, in terms of minimum eligibility criteria for M.Phil. and Ph.D. Programme, it was decided that Master Degree with 55% marks (50% marks for SC/ST/OBC(Non creamy layer)/PH) holders are eligible for M.Phil. or Ph.D. admission. Since M.A. Degree holders are eligible for both the programmes, it was proposed that M.Phil. Programmes may be delinked, as done by the many Universities.
5. It was agreed that PGDE could not be equated with Degree programmes.
6. The necessary amendments in the Ordinance with regard to the above will be incorporated by the committee set up by the Vice-Chancellor in the Chairmanship of Prof. Rajendra Dengle, Dean School of Language, Literature & Culture Studies.
7. In order to examine the matter of equivalence of the M. Tech. Degree with Master's level or Pre-Doctoral level programme, a committee consisting of Dean, School of Computer & System Sciences, Chairperson, Special Centre for Nano Sciences and A.R. (Evaluation) as member secretary was proposed. The Committee will come up with its recommendations for the next meeting of the Standing Committee on Admissions.
