**CIRCULAR**

It has been observed that the course work for Ph.D students has not been prescribed/offered in many Centres and Schools. However, so far, as per UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degrees ) Regulations, 2016, course work in Ph.D programme is mandatory.

In this regard, relevant modifications have been done in the Ph.D ordinance of the University. Therefore, all the Schools/Centres/Spl. Centres where course work in Ph.D programme has not been offered to the students, admitted in Winter Semester 2017 onwards, may kindly **be offered the same in compliance of the Ph.D ordinance** and **UGC Regulations 2016**.

However, the matter of the students admitted in Monsoon Semester 2016 is sub-judice, hence, the final decision will be taken according to the judgment/order to be given by the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in this case. In case, UGC regulations/ any other guideline make the course work mandatory, students be informed that they will have to complete the course work;
