1. The Schedule of Admission for the year 2017-18.

2. There will be desynchronization in result declaration; and results once finalized by the respective Schools / Centres will be announced.
3. The prospectus will mention the tentative date of *viva-voce* to enable the candidates to make timely arrangements for their travel etc.
4. Candidates need to regularly check the University website for the exact date of the *viva voce*. No separate communication will be sent in this regard.

5. **Modes of admission to M.Phil/Ph.D programme**

Six modes of admission in M.Phil/Ph.D programmes will be there:

Through Entrance Examination

- i) M.Phil/M.Tech/Pre-Ph.D/MPH - Ph.D Integrated for candidates possessing Master's degree;
- ii) M.Phil/M.Tech.
- iii) M.Sc. - Ph.D integrated
- iv) M.Phil/M.Tech/Pre-Ph.D/MPH-Ph.D Integrated for candidates possessing JRF/UGC NET
- v) Ph.D for JRF/UGC NET holders
- vi) Ph.D for M.Phil holders or equivalent qualification.

Various fellowship holders such as UGC/CSIR NET and others who have passed M.Phil Programmes will go through an Entrance Test for selection. Methods of such tests will be decided by the respective Schools/Centres.

(a) **Entrance Test**

There will be three-stage examination pattern - **Part-A: Preliminary examination** paper based on research methodology and domain knowledge (OMR) type; **Part-B: Descriptive/ Subjective written test (subject specific)**; and **Part-C: Interview/Viva-Voce**. If a candidate does not secure 50% marks in the preliminary examination (Part-A), the descriptive type paper (Part-B) will not be evaluated.

(b) **Weightage of written & viva-voce**

The weightage given to descriptive written test (**Part-B**) and *viva-voce* (**Part-C**) respectively, will be 80:20 marks.

(c) **Award of Deprivation Points**

The deprivation points, wherever applicable, will be added to the total score of the candidates in Part-B and Part-C, and coded merit lists are drawn and forwarded to respective Schools/ Centers.

**6. Committee's recommendations on District Quartile**

As per the recommendations of the District Quartile Committee, a four-point criteria will be adopted.

**7. Inclusion of JNU Wards and J&K supernumerary seats in Admission Policy of the University**

After considering the same, the Committee recommended that the same be suitably incorporated in the Admission Policy of the University.

**8. Intake**

The student intake into various programmes of the University will be decided on the basis of the UGC Regulations 2016, which states: "6.5: A Research Supervisor/Co-supervisor who is a Professor, at any given point of time, cannot guide more than three (3) M.Phil. and Eight (8) Ph.D. scholars. An Associate Professor as Research Supervisor can guide up to a maximum of two (2) M.Phil. and six (6) Ph.D. scholars and an Assistant Professor as Research Supervisor can guide up to a maximum of one (1) M.Phil. and four (4) Ph.D. scholars."
