On this, the Dean of Students apprised the Council that all possible efforts have been taken to accommodate all the outstation students. He further added that the University is in the process of issuing smart card to all the registered students when the University reopens after winter vacation.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">(Action: Dean of Students)</p>	<p>All the students (boys & girls), who had taken admission for the academic year 2017-18, have been accommodated in hostels. All SC/ST students (boys & girls) have been allotted hostels on the very same day of admission. Further, new dormitory for boys has been opened to accommodate the outstation students last year. One dormitory for girls in Narmada Extension is under construction. One mega hostel named Saraswati exclusive for girls and one hostel named Barak for boys have laid the foundation stone and expected to open for allotment in next three years.</p>
