Guidelines to work out /draw intake for the A. Y. 2017-18

Dear Sir/Madam,

With reference to our circular Ref./Eval.1/3(43A)/2017, dated 6 February 2017, this is to clarify that the data published/uploaded on the website of the University is the present (Winter Semester 2017) positions/intake of the M.Phil and Ph.D students received from the Centres/Schools.

This is not about the decision related to intake for Academic Year 2017-18.

The Deans/Chairpersons/faculty members were requested to check the details and inform, if any inconsistency/mistake is found. However, this office received ambiguous and inconclusive information. Some Centres/ Schools rectified uploaded data, some worked out their own intake for A.Y. 2017-18 and some asked for clarifications.

A meeting of the Rector-I, Director of Admission, A.R.(Evaluation), A.R.(Admission) and System Analyst (Sh. S. Venkatesan) was held on 15/2/2017 at Convention Centre, due to current students agitation and blockade/occupation of the admin building. The recommendations of the committee constituted by the competent authority to find out ways to implement intake according to the UGC Regulation,2016 were discussed. After detailed deliberation, the following decisions were taken:

1. Students registered/admitted for the A.Y. 2016-17, including during the transition period between 5th May, 2016 (the date of Gazette publication) to 7th October, 2016 (the date of AC meeting), will be treated as admitted. However, other clauses of the Regulation need to be adhered to.
2. As per the UGC Regulation, 2016, superannuated faculties, re-employed faculties, Research Scientists, part-time/ad-hoc/guest teachers, faculties without Ph.D. degree and UGC-Recharge faculties are not eligible to act as supervisor(s) and, hence, cannot be taken into consideration to work out intake.
3. The number of students enrolled under 9(b) clause of Ph.D. Ordinance of the University and students who are in final Semester of the Ph.D. programmes, as per the Ordinance, will be considered as possible vacant seat while calculating intake positions for the A.Y. 2017-18 admissions.
4. The number of students who are registered in 4th Semester of M.Phil. (integrated M.Phil/Ph.D.) programmes, are writing M.Phil. dissertations and students registered under provisional Ph.D. will be considered as continuing student as part of M.Phil./Ph.D. integrated programme.
5. Students who are registered under Ph.D. programmes and who are in last semester of their programme will be considered as vacant seats.
6. The number of students who are registered in the M.Phil./M.Tech./Pre-Ph.D. programmes for the A.Y. 2016-17 and doing course work will be considered as continuing students of the programme.
7. The faculty members who have excess number of students, as per clause 6.5 of the UGC regulation, 2016, may continue with the present number of students as supervisor. However, he/she can take new intake only after the number comes down to the limit prescribed under the above mentioned clause.

In view of the above, it is requested to kindly draw the intake of your Centre/School as per clause 6.5 of the UGC Regulation, 2016 and on the basis of the above, and send the same to the undersigned (E-mail: dr_eval@mail.jnu.ac.in), in the attached format, by Monday, the 20th February, 2017. In view of the urgency of the matter, if no reply is received in the stipulated time and as per the UGC Regulation, 2016, as mentioned above, it will be assumed that the concerned centre is not willing to take new intake for the A.Y. 2017-18.

This issues with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor.
