ADDITIONAL AFFIDAVIT ON BEHALF OF JAWAHARLAL NEHRU UNIVERSITY

MOST RESPECTFULLY SHOWETH:

I, Dr. Pramod Kumar S/o Shri J. P. Roy, aged about 53 years, working as Registrar, Jawaharlal Nehru University(JNU), New Delhi, do hereby solemnly affirm and declare as under:

That I am working as Registrar with the Petitioner and am aware of the facts of the case from the records being maintained in the ordinary course of business by the Petitioner and competent to swear this affidavit on behalf of Petitioner.

1. That by way of the present Affidavit the Petitioner seeks to bring on record the actions of the Contemnors which are in violation of the order of this Hon'ble Court dated 09/08/2017.

2. It is submitted that on 10/02/2018 the Contemnors alongwith other students had started to gather right outside the administrative block i.e. within the 100 meter radius in violation of order dated 09/08/2017 to protest against the mandatory attendance rule implemented by the University.
3. That the Petitioner University sent several requests to the contemnors to not protest within 100 meters of the Administrative Block as it would be violating the Order passed by this Hon'ble Court. However, the contemnors continued to carry out the protests and on 15/02/2018, Rector-I and Rector 3 were illegally detained by the Contemnors in the Administrative Block which prompted the University to file the present Contempt Petition.
4. That the video footage alongwith the transcript attached with the present Affidavit as Annexure A-1(Colly), which was available on the social media, clearly shows that Contemnor No.1 had detained Rector-I within the Administrative Block. The timing of the video footage is of approximately 9.30 PM. The video clearly shows that Prof. Hari Ram Mishra went to meet the Rector-I and Rector- III detained by the contemnors in the Administrative Block. Contemnor No.1 did not let him through and eventually asked Prof. Hari Ram Mishra to come "tomorrow morning during the office hours". The entire video footage makes it evident that the Contemnors had detained the Rector-I and Rector-III. Furthermore, Prof. Hari Ram Mishra was also not allowed to enter the Administrative Block by the Contemnors thereby stopping the ingress and egress of the officials.

5. That in video 2 filed alongwith the Petition shows that Rector-I had to be carried out by the ambulance at approximately 1:30 AM in the morning amidst the commotion and clear attempts being made by the students to stop Rector-I from leaving the building.
6. That the Affidavits of the Rector-I and the Chief Security officer giving their details of the incident dated 15/02/2018 are annexed as **Annexure A-2 (Colly)**.
7. That the intention of the Contemnors and the students can also be made out from the series of subsequent unfortunate events that have taken place outside the 100 meters of the Administrative Block. On 12/03/2018 the Contemnors alongwith other Students while protesting against the mandatory attendance rule barged intooffice of the Dean of Students, Prof. Umesh Kadam. After deliberating with the students for sometime regarding the mandatory attendance issue at approximately 3:15 PM, the Dean of the Students was forcibly stopped by the Contemnors from leaving his office. One of the students also grabbed Prof. Umesh Kadam by his collar and pushed him on several occasions during the scuffle. The students also were engaged in a fist fight with the Security Officials. The video footage of the scuffle with the security guards and the Dean of Students is in video 3. Copy of Video1, Video2 and Video 3 is already annexed as Annexure A-1 (Colly). The Dean of Students had to be encircled by the Security Guards in order to carry him out of the office amidst violent protesters. Copy of the security report along is annexed as **Annexure A-3**.

8. That it is also pertinent to mention that after 15/02/2018, the Contemnors have been carrying out protest across the University campus and not in the Sabarmati Lawns which was earmarked by the Hon'ble Court vide its order dated 09/08/2017. The Contemnors have virtually stopped the classes in School of Languages, School of Arts and Aesthetics, School of Life Sciences, School of International Studies and School of Social Sciences. The Contemnors have on certain occasions put lock on the doors of the School Buildings as well as obstructed the teachers and the Professors from taking their classes. That the obstruction of classes was done on 15/03/2018, 16/03/2018, 20/03/2018, 21/03/2018, 22/03/2018, 23/03/2018, 24/03/2018, 25/03/2018, 26/03/2018 & 27/03/2018. The details of these incidents is described in the CSO Report alongwith photographs is annexed as **Annexure A-4 (Colly)**.
9. The students including Geeta Kumari and Shubanshu Singh demonstrated for several hours at the residence of the Rector I situated within the University Campus on 17/03/2018. Loud sloganeering and use of unacceptable language by the protesters psychologically affected the members of his family. The university rules do not permit holding of protest demonstrations and other forms of protests near the residential complexes in the campus. Copy of the CSO Report dated 24/03/2018 regarding the said incident is annexed as **Annexure A-5**.
10. The actions of the contemnors have brought the entire functioning of the University to a standstill. The actions of the Contemnors both within and outside the 100 meters of the Administrative Block demonstrate the intent and

aggressive nature of the protests which is not peaceful. The contemnors have the right to protest but not at the expense of the functioning of the University officials and destroying the careers of thousands of students.

In view of the aforementioned facts and circumstances it is most respectfully prayed to this Hon'ble Court to allow the present petition in favour of the Petitioner and against the Respondents.

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- I have come for the confinement of the students. Our Ranaji is a teacher in life sciences and Chintamani Mahapatra..... (Noise of the students).

Students:- You have come to have dialog or to interfere? Please tell (Students started making noise).

Geeta Kumari:- Have silence, please listen.

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- We support the demand. We have no problem. Whether you mark attendance or not it's your choice. The students who are here, they mark attendance or not it is their responsibility. Our work is to teach.

Students:- You take attendance or not? Please tell.

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- Yes, we take.

Students:- (The students chanted the slogans of Murdabad, Murdabad while opposing the points of Prof. Hari Ram Mishra.

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- Just a minute, just a minute, just a minute! If you allow, we will go otherwise we won't.

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- It's your democratic right. Whatever you do but the confinement of a teacher is not appropriate.

Geeta Kumari:- Have come to have dialog with us.

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- We are talking. Why don't you allow us to go?

Geeta Kumari:- You please wait (looking him in the eyes)

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- No, No, No, No! Please listen, Let me go. Why don't you allow?

Geeta Kumari:- Let me speak. (Shouting on Prof. Hari Ram Mishra), did you ask before organizing a press conference there?

Students:- Making noise. (Nahi chalegi, nahi chalegi)

Geeta Kumari:- Have silence, have silence!

Geeta Kumari:- Before press conference, before organizing it.

Prof Hari Ram Mishra:- I didn't call the press.

Geeta Kumari: Wait a moment, wait a moment. I also didn't call it. They came in individual capacity, listen.

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- Yeah, listening. Yes please.

Geeta Kumari:- Listen, before-organizing the press conference had you seen whether the confinement was done or not?

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- I was coming later.....

Geeta Kumari:- Coming, Don't tell us.

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- No, no, no. I was interrupted on the way.

Geeta Kumari:- Which student interrupted you? You have come here and reached.

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- No, no, no. o o o o (Students making noise ye ye ye)

Geeta Kumari:- Don't tell a lie in front of us. Don't tell a lie in front of us.

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- No, no there is no lie in it.

Geeta Kumari:- Don't tell a lie in front of us.

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:-No, no there is no lie in it. The students who went there I would identify them if they come to my light.

Geeta Kumari: Earlier, You and we have been there four times, have been there four times.....

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- The press has nothing to do with us, nothing to do with us.....

Geeta Kumari:- The press has nothing to do with us, earlier?

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- As, I am telling that we cannot ask a teacher to do some work?

Geeta Kumari:- We have not confined anyone.....

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- Then, why has he been stopped (the noise of the students continuing)

Geeta Kumari:- Come in the office hours tomorrow. (Pointing to the wrist, noise of the student continuing, clapping)

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- No, What happened just now No, What happened just now, won't allow him to go?

Geeta Kumari:- Don't make us understand.

Prof. Hari Ram Mishra:- Won't you allow him to go?

Students:- Push the touts of the admin one more time, Push the touts of the admin one more time, Push the touts of the admin one more time. Leave the campus, leave the campus. Won't accept flattery, won't accept, won't accept..... (Darkness looming large and the students continued making noise).

प्रोफेसर हरी राम मिश्रा :- मैं इसलिए आया हूँ की जो छात्रों की कन्फाइनेमेंट है हमारे राणा जी जो लाइफ साइंस के एक अध्यापक हैं और चिंतामणि महापात्रा... (छात्रों का शोर)।

गीता कुमारी: शांत रहिये सुनिए।

प्रोफेसर हरी राम मिश्रा: एक मिनट एक मिनट एक मिनट आप allow करेंगे तो हम जायेंगे नहीं allow करेंगे तो हम नहीं जायेंगे।

प्रोफेसर हरी राम मिश्रा: आपका डेमोक्रेटिक राइट है आप जो भी करो किन्तु एक अध्यापक का कांफिनेमेंट ठीक नहीं है।

गीता कुमारी : हमसे बतियाने आये हैं हम से बतियाने आये हैं।

प्रोफेसर हरी राम मिश्रा: हम बतिया रहे हैं। हमें जाने क्यूँ नहीं दे रहे।

गीता कुमारी : आप रुकिए न (आँखें दिकाते हुए)।

प्रोफेसर हरी राम मिश्रा: नहीं नहीं नहीं नहीं सुनिए हमें जाने क्यूँ नहीं दे रहे हैं?

गीता कुमारी : हमें बोलने दीजिये (प्रोफेसर हरी राम मिश्रा पर चिल्लाते हुए), वहाँ पे प्रेस कांफ्रेंस करने से पहले पुछा था?

स्टूडेंट्स : हल्ला (नहीं चलेगी नहीं चलेगी)।

गीता कुमारी : शांत रहिये! शांत रहिये।

गीता कुमारी : प्रेस कांफ्रेंस से पहले करने से पहले।

प्रोफेसर हरी राम मिश्रा: प्रेस मैंने नहीं बुलाया।

गीता कुमारी : रुकिए न रुकिए रुकिए मैंने भी नहीं बुलाया था इंडिविजुअल कैपेसिटी में आये हैं न सुनिए..

प्रोफेसर हरी राम मिश्रा: हाँ सुन रहा हूँ। हाँ बताओ।

गीता कुमारी : सुनिए आपने प्रेस कांफ्रेंस करने से पहले यहाँ आकर देखा था की नहीं के कांफिनेमेंट हुआ है की नहीं?

प्रोफेसर हरी राम मिश्रा: हम आ रहे थे पीछे...

गीता कुमारी : आ रहे थे मत बताइए।

प्रोफेसर हरी राम मिश्रा: न न हमें रास्ते में रोका गया।

गीता कुमारी : कौन छात्र रोका अभी आप आये हैं यहाँ तक पहुंचे।

प्रोफेसर हरी राम मिश्रा: नहीं नहीं नहीं ओ ओ ओ... (छात्रों का हल्ला ये ये ये)

गीता कुमारी : आमने सामने झूठ मत बोलिए। आमने सामने झूठ मत बोलिए।

प्रोफेसर हरी राम मिश्रा: नहीं नहीं झूठ नहीं इसमें।

AFFIDAVIT ON BEHALF OF CHINTAMANI MAHAPATRA, RECTOR-I JAWAHARLAL NEHRU
UNIVERSITY REGARDING INCIDENT DATED 15/02/2018

MOST RESPECTFULLY SHOWETH:

I, Chintamani Mahapatra, S/o Late Sri Harekrishna Mahapatra, aged about 60 years, Rector 1 of JNU, do hereby state as under:

1. I, Prof. Chintamani Mahapatra, Rector 1 of JNU reached my office in the Administrative Building at 9:00 AM on 15th February 2018. I had an official engagement in the School of Language, Literature and Culture Studies and when I went to that School around 10:00 AM, I saw a group of students led by JNUSU office bearers standing at the gate of the building. I say that JNUSU President Geeta Kumari and Joint Secretary Subhanshu Singh walked into the building and expressed their desire to speak with me.
2. I state that when I agreed to speak for a few minutes, they Ms. Geeta Kumari and Mr. Shubhanshu Singh requested me to arrange a meeting with the Vice Chancellor. I said that they should approach the VC Office for appointment and that if I would meet him, I would also request him on their behalf. I took advantage of this meeting to advise them to refrain from holding demonstrations or protests at prohibited areas and to press for their demands without violating any rule to which they agreed. I made this suggestion, since I knew that JNUSU had given a call to students to assemble at the Administration Building at 11:30 AM that day.

3. I state that after my official engagement was over at the School, I returned to my office around 11:00 AM to resume work. I further say that around noontime many students began to assemble at the Administration Building. There was no report of the students blocking any one from entering or exiting the building. By lunch time, I was informed by the security officials that number of students was gaining strength. I was also told that the student groups also were assembling at various entry points to the administrative building. Around 1:30 PM, I, along with Rector 3, Prof. RanaPratap Singh, went down from my office to the indoor parking of the building which is in the ground floor of the Administrative Block. I say that as both of us began to exit the gate in Prof. Singh's car, dozens of students blocked our way and forced us to come out of the car. I further say that loud slogans were shouted naming me (Rector Chintamani Mahapatra/Murdabad); and a large group of students menacingly advanced towards the car, stood in front of the car and demanded a dialogue. I say that Mr. Shubhanshu Singh with a few other students surrounded me and demanded a meeting with the VC. I said that they should contact the VC office and allow us to go home for lunch. But they would not relent. I say that the assembled students began loud and offensive sloganeering and said that they would not allow us to leave until they had a meeting with the VC. Since we had no other option, I told them that let me try and then went back to the office.
4. I state that since these students were turning violent by snatching the mobile phone of a security personnel and were abusing him in a chorus, myself and Prof. Singh thought it wise to return to the office.
5. I say that in the midst of offensive slogan shouting and blocking our car from moving out, I along with Rector 3 retreated back to the office. I state that this incident is described by the protesting students as not the one blocking ingress and egress. Nothing could be farther from the truth. The fact was that I was not allowed to go home for lunch. I was forced to return to the office building.
6. I say that the second incident of preventing me from leaving the administration building occurred a few hours later. I state that I had a class at 4 PM in the School of International Studies. Therefore, I made another attempt to go out of the Admin Building to take my scheduled class. I say that since a large number of students were listening to some speech by one of their leaders, I climbed down the steps in the opposite direction and proceeded towards the School of International Studies. Once some students spotted me walking out of the building, they called a large crowd of students to rush towards me. I say that I had walked about fifty meters along the path, when a crowd of students reached, surrounded me and began to hurl abuses on me, manhandled me, demanded

my resignation and forced me back to the Admin Building. I say that some of the students were literally pushing me back towards the Administration Building. I further say that at the foot of the steps leading up to the entrance of the Administration Building, some of them said let him go inside the building, but others forced me speak to the large gathering of students on mike. I said that I am not the sole decision maker and that they could not force me to take positions on their issues.

7. Thus, I was forced back into the administration building. I say that it was a clear-cut case of blocking my egress and that too to perform my duty as teacher and take class. I was not allowed to go for my class.
8. I kept working from my office room until about 10 PM when I felt giddy and a little pain in my arms. I requested medical attention. I say that one on-duty doctor and a paramedic came to my office with great difficulty. I was told that they had hard time getting into the building since the protesters were preventing them from entering the building. I say that after checking my blood pressure, and finding that it was life threatening, the doctor advised hospitalization. I say that when I came out of the building, along with the security personnel and the doctors, the crowd of students rushed towards me, shouting abuses and trying to prevent me from leaving the building. I say that I felt very giddy and was about to fall down, when someone caught hold of me, carried me on his back towards the Ambulance.
9. I say that it was a truly scary situation for me when I was exposed before a large gathering of protesters and the offensive slogans were deafening. I could hear someone screaming, "let him die". As my blood pressure was already quite high, it further elevated my stress level. I managed to get into the ambulance with great difficulty. I state that as I was climbing inside the ambulance, some of the protesters were trying to pull me out. I state that as I stumbled my way into the ambulance, another round of stressful developments took place. Protesters hammered the ambulance with their fists from outside. I thought for a moment that my last time was approaching. I state that I could hear security personnel requesting the protesters not to put two-wheelers in front of the ambulance. I state that later I was told that one of the protesters snatched the key of ambulance to prevent the ambulance from leaving. All efforts were made to prevent the ambulance from moving by the protestors. I state that as and when the security personnel managed it, and the ambulance began to move and bumped into the main road, some protesters chased the

ambulance to the West gate of the university. I state that the race towards the gate and the bumps and left-right movement of the ambulance gave me enormous physical pain and mental agony.

10. I say that I was then taken to Indian Spinal Injuries Centre in Vasant Kunj for medical checkup.

MOST RESPECTFULLY SHOWETH:

I, Naveen yadav, S/o ^{Dr. P. S. Yadav}....., aged about 42 years, CSO of JNU, do hereby state as under:

1. I say that since 15.02.2018 morning a huge number of Students had been blocking all the entry and exit points of administrative building. I say that at around 2.00 PM Rector – I and Rector – III were going out of admin parking in their car when students blocked their path by standing in front of the car and didn't let them go. Rectors told them and requested them to let them go for lunch but students shouted at them and didn't let them go. So, they went back to their offices.
2. Again at around 4.00 PM Rector – I had a class to teach and he went out from the main entrance of Administrative Building but students again

chased him, shouted at him with abuses, misbehaved with him and pushed him.

3. I state that at around 6.00 PM Chief Proctor tried to exit from the Admin Building from Admin – II side but students didn't allow him to go and kept him captive for one hour by making a human chain surrounding him. They let him go only after at least one hour and many requests from him. I state that Rector – I and Rector – III were still inside without having lunch and even dinner. I state that at around 10 PM few teachers wanted to come inside the admin building but again students pushed and misbehaved with all of them and didn't let them go inside. Few of the teachers even fell down due to this.
4. I say that Rector – I started feeling sick and uneasy with complains of pain in his arms and chest. Immediately the ambulance was called and night duty doctor with a paramedic came inside with great difficulty due to the resistance of the students. Doctor immediately checked the vitals of Rector – I and found his Blood Pressure very high and in immediate need of shifting him to hospital in emergency.
5. I say that the Doctor and paramedic started to bring him to ambulance by assisting him while walking. But when they reached the main gate of Admin Building the students blocked their way. I say that they told the protestors that it was a medical emergency but they still started pushing them.
6. I say that in this pushing and pulling Rector – I fainted the security personnel carried him on their shoulders but all the students were still

pulling him down and blocking the path to ambulance. I say that with great difficulty the security could reach to ambulance and placed him inside.

7. I state that when the driver tried to start the ambulance some student tried to snatch the key of ambulance from him but it was prevented by a teacher in which his hand was also injured. I say that thereafter the students pulled the steering wheel of ambulance while the driver started to move it. I say that ultimately he could move the ambulance with the help of security. Ambulance was straight taken to Indian Spinal Injuries Centre, Vasant Kunj and Rector – I was admitted to emergency.



01. As per daily diary report of Security Department, on 12.03.2018 about 11.50 am there were protests by the JNU Students Union in front of the office of the Dean of students. In this connection a pamphlet was also issued on 11.03.2018 by the Students Union (Copy enclosed). Along with 30/35 Students Shashi Kant Tripathi, Kaushik Raj and Simone Zoya Khan started sloganeering in front of office of the Dean of Students. Students Union representative Simone Zoya Khan asked the security guards to inform the Dean of students that all hostel president want to meet him. In this connection Prof. Umesh Ashok Kadam was informed. He asked them (Hostel President) to come in office. After their entry in the office Dean of students and Mr. Deepak Arya (Assistant Registrar) began to discuss each other. The discussion continued till 14.30, about 14.30 pm some of the students came out of the office and told other students that Dean of students is not acceding to any demands of the students. Even after obstructing by the security guards other students sitting outside Shashi Tripathi, Kaushik Raj, Cheple Sherpa, Pratim Ghoshal, Suborni Charkraborti, Sarthak Bhatia, Sughananya, Subhanshu Singh forcibly entered the office of the Dean of students. When the Security Guards obstructed the students to enter DSW, they made their way to DSW office and asked him to repeat in front of other students what he earlier told in the room before hostel presidents. Only then would leave the office of the DSW. Dean of students asked all the students to come in the office. As soon as the students reached the office of Prof. Umesh Ashok Kadam, Dean of students they asked him to give in writing all that he said, otherwise they would not go out and all the students seated on the sofa. The discussion continued between Dean of students & other students.
02. About 15:15 pm when Prof. Umesh Ashok Kadam, Dean of students started to go out from the office, he was obstructed by the students and students named Kaushik Raj and Student Shashi Kant Tripathi pushed the Dean of students and caught him by the collar. When security guards mediated, students then Students Sarthak Bhata pushed Mr. Ramesh Pawar (Manager G4's) through the neck. Dean of Students got back to his office and sat on his seat. After some time, all the students left the office. The Dean of Students was brought out from the office in the security ring of security Guards and he was taken to the Health Center). After reaching the Health Center, The Dean of Students apprised the Doctor in detail that he got injured in the hand and neck due to pushing and shoving by the Students. Doctor at Health Centre referred him to Safdarjung Hospital immediately, MLC of Prof. Umesh Ashok Kadam, Dean of Students was conducted at Safdarjung Hospital.

1. As per the daily diary report, on 15-03-2018 at about 08:45 hrs Shri Sukhveer Singh (Assistant Manager, G4S) informed that some students have locked the SAA building. Shri Sunil Kumar (Security Assistant) reached the location immediately and came to know that a student named Sourodeep Dey, ID no. 73707 has locked the main gate of the school building and 15-20 other students cordoned off the main gate. The security guards tried to get them away from the main gate but in vain. When Prof. Mazhar Asif (Acting Dean, SAA) reached the main gate to enter the office of School of Arts and Aesthetics at about 13:00 hrs, the available students did not allow him to enter the office and neither allowed any other employee to enter the office building. Prof. Asif exhorted the students to open the main gate of the school by having dialogue but the student did not pay heed to him. The students locked the main gate of the school building with the help of iron chain. Prof. Asif returned without doing any work. On 16th March 2018 about 10:55 hrs Prof. Mazhar Asif came to his office (SAA building) for the conduct of viva-voce for new students, the available students again denied Prof. Mazhar Asif to enter the school building and indulged in unnecessary debate. Prof. Asif told them time and again that the conduct the viva-voce for new students is compulsory and if not conducted in time than new students might be the sufferers. But the students did not pay heed to his points and kept the school gate closed forcefully. This way the students obstructed the government official to perform their official duty. The security guards tried to get them away from the school gate and unlock the gate but the students started opposing them and obstructed the security guards to do so and the students came to blows with them. The students have occupied the school building till date and they are not allowing the Dean to enter the building. This way, numerous problems are being faced in the conduct of viva-voce,



I attended the Navruz function organized by the Persian Centre in the SSS Audi and then went to the Korean Centre in the SL Annexe to chair a selection committee meeting for Guest Faculty. Both could take place in relative peace.

The second issue that I wish to report is what happened yesterday in the interviews held for COP Bahasa Indonesia, which, as you know, is part of the Chinese and East Asian Studies headed by Prof P Mukherjee. This is purely a Centre affair. Neither was I approached for advice while constituting the selection committee, nor was I involved in the proceedings in any way till I was told that some representatives of the students union were disrupting the interviews as they had an issue with the composition of the committee. I advised the Course incharge to have the Chairperson on board and see whether the guidelines issued by the Admissions Branch were complied with and then take a call whether the interviews needed to be rescheduled while urging the student representatives not to disrupt the interviews. I had a word with Director Admissions in this regard as well.

Today, while the Korean Centre interviews were about to begin, Prof Mukherjee appeared there with a student councillor asking for my advice in the matter! I reiterated that he had to discuss the matter with the course incharge of Bahasa Indonesia and his other colleagues and take a decision.

I am unhappy that a Course In Charge runs to the Dean and not the Chair - for firefighting, and the Chair does the same without consulting the faculty, while the Dean is not consulted at all at any stage prior to allowing such unnecessarily emergent situations to arise (I am not suggesting that this is necessary, the Centre faculty is competent to take decisions on such matters -). And in no way I am suggesting that student representatives disrupting interviews and demanding in writing why an observer for SC/ST/OBC candidates was not in place is acceptable.

I am sorry for a slightly long post, but I am sure you would understand.

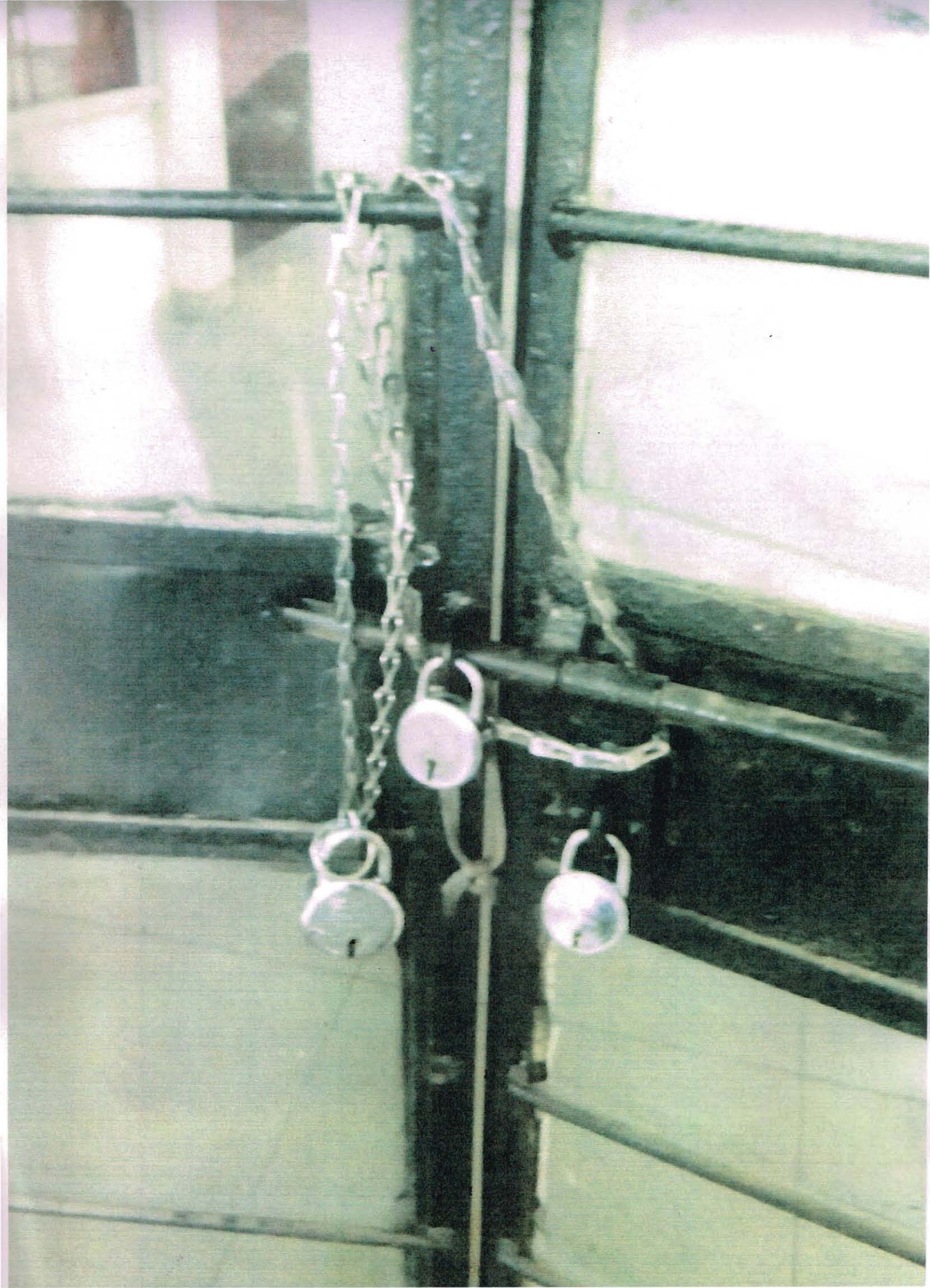

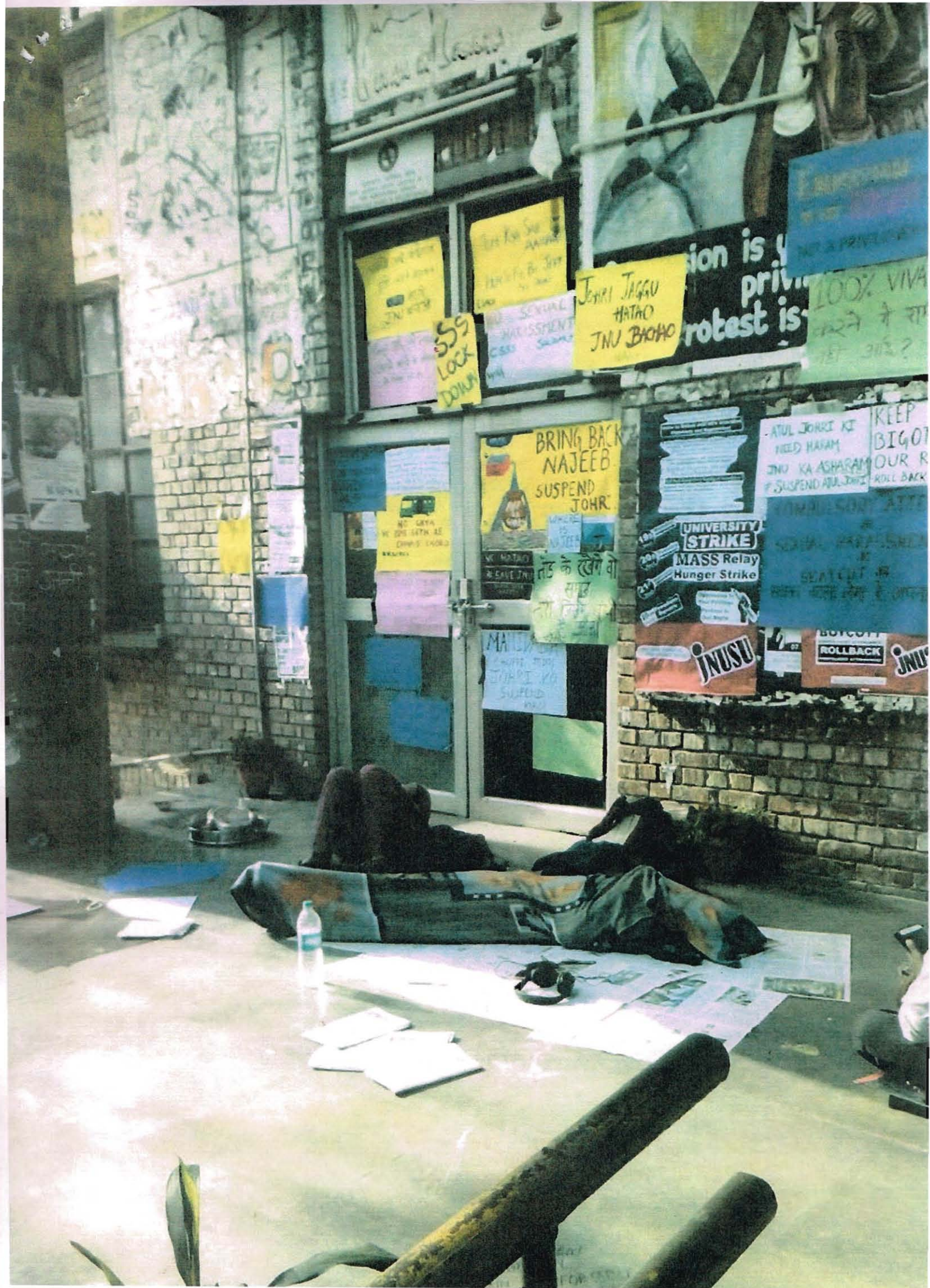

1 दैनिक डायरी रिपोर्ट के अनुसार दिनांक 17/03/2018 को समय करीब 13:30 बजे ज ने वि छात्र संघ सहित 60-70 छात्र छात्राएं सावरमती लॉन से नारा लागते हुए प्रोफेसर चितामणि महापात्रा, कुलदेशिक-1, मकान संख्या 7, दक्षिणापुरम पहुंचे। चूंकि सूर्य के माध्यम से सुरक्षा कर्मियों को पूर्व में ही पता चल गया था कि छात्र कुलदेशिक आवास पर धराब करेंगे इसी कारण उनके घर के बाहर बैरिकेड लगाकर सुरक्षा कर्मियों की संख्या अधिक कर दी गई थी। यह सभी छात्र प्रोफेसर अतुल जोहरी के विरोध में व प्रशासन द्वारा कोई भी कार्यवाही न किये जाने के विरोध में नारे लगा रहे थे। छात्र कुलदेशिक आवास के बाहर खड़े होकर कुलदेशिक से मिलने के लिए बोलने लगे सुरक्षा कर्मियों ने उन्हें बताया कि कुलदेशिक महोदय आवश्यक मीटिंग के चलते परिसर से बाहर गए हैं। छात्रों को सुरक्षा कर्मियों द्वारा बताये जाने के उपरान्त भी छात्र कुलदेशिक महोदय के आवास के बाहर बैठे रहे और कहने लगे जब तक कुलदेशिक महोदय उनसे नहीं मिलेंगे तब तक वे वहां से नहीं हटेंगे। छात्र कुलदेशिक महोदय के घर के बाहर ही घरने पर बैठ गए और कई पत्रकारों को भी एकत्र कर रखा था।
