The website on which my profile has been categorically mentioned, with my full name and photograph can be found on this link



Circulation of whatsapp message with my profile's link, e-mails with the link to the above mentioned website and similar status updates on Facebook are very disturbing for me. Not only is this an infringement of my privacy, it is also deeply unsettling for me that the link to my profile is being circulated publicly. This also amounts to defamation and is a concerted effort to stir public opinion against me.
