Sir,

Today on 26<sup>th</sup> October I received a letter dated 17<sup>th</sup> Oct 2017 through e-mail from your office. In the said letter, I am informed that a complaint had been filed against me, in which it has been alleged that I was involved in "physical assault, man handling and verbal abuse" against Mr. Buddha Singh and a fellow student Rohit Kumar. Therefore I am called by your office to explain myself on November 2, 2017.

I was really shocked to read the notice served to me as everything mentioned in the notice was false, and the notice uses really strong words and alleges me to some very serious allegation which were completely surprising to me as none of it happened, all the allegations put against me are completely false.

Sir, I am ready to fully co-operate with any enquiry initiated by your office. Additionally, I think it's important to bring to your notice that your office hadn't provided me with any document including the copy of the complaint and any related evidential proof related to the so called allegation. Because when the notice uses so serious allegations with strong words, how can I defend myself in abstract without any material evidence. I believe this is also a clear violation of the principle of natural justice. Therefore, I humbly request you to first of all provide me all the relevant documents beforehand.
