With reference to the 9 February 2016 incident of JNU campus, the High Level Enquiry Committee (HLEC) has found Ms. Banojyotsna Lahiri, an outsider, guilty on the following counts.

The university 'Rules and discipline and proper conduct of students of JNU', Clause 3 – Categories of misconduct and indiscipline', Category-II, Sub-Category (xxv) prohibits 'Any other act which may be considered by the VC or any other competent authority to be an act of violation of discipline and conduct'.

As per the HLEC recommendation, Ms. Banojyotsna Lahiri, an outsider, has been found guilty of

- (a) participating in the organizing the event at Sabarmati Dhaba
- (b) participating in objectionable sloganeering

The Vice-Chancellor, in exercise of his powers vested in him under Statute 32(5) of the Statutes of the University, has ordered that Ms. Banojyotsna Lahiri be declared out of bounds from the entire JNU Campus with immediate effect for a period of five years.

Any one giving shelter to Ms. Banojyotsna Lahiri in any premises of the University will invite strict disciplinary action against him/her.

She is also debarred from taking admission in any programme of study of this University in future.
