The Den of Secessionism and Terrorism

Attention is hereby invited to the serious seditious activities that have been going on in India's prestigious Jawaharlal Nehru University, which was established in 1969 as an advanced academic institution to foster national integration, composite culture, international understanding, scientific temper and to present an Indo-centric view of world affairs. It is a matter of serious concern that some JNU academics masquerading as liberals and feminists have been engaged in nefarious and anti-national activities of maligning India publicly through their statements, lectures, publications and extra-academic activities of their NGOs which receive liberal funding from foreign hostile agencies. The problem is compounded by the fact that these very few academics brainwash and recruit the guillible and academically weak students into their fold in order to use them as cannon fodder in various rallies, demonstrations etc. organized by them both in and outside the JNU campus. The University has thus become a den of subversive activities by these few JNU dons who are rationalizing the agenda of terrorism and secessionism in Kashmir, North-East and Maoist infested belt. These incidents in JNU have stifled and suffocated the silent majority of JNUites - teachers, students and staff, who feel threatened in performing their day to day academic activities. The following facts are revealing and speak for themselves:

1. Shahbud Din Gauri, who was a registered student of JNU and resident of Kaveri hostel, was a Pakistani agent and the lynchpin of Jain hawala scandal. His active involvement in terrorist activities in Kashmir and his association with ISI activities was proved by Delhi Police which busted this racket in early 1991. Shahabud Din was using the JNU campus as a safe hideout for his seditious activities. (Please see Delhi Police Commissioner's Press Release dated 10-4-1991 - copy enclosed).
2. John Cockerill, a Canadian national, who studied and stayed in JNU campus, used JNU as a base for his anti-Indian activities in Kashmir. He was guided and supported in his task by Prof. Kamal Mitra Chenoy and Prof. Anuradha Chenoy, both in the School of International Studies. For this very reason, Cockerill was later expelled from India by the Government of India.

3. Several anti-India fronts/NGOs like JUGNU, SAWERA, All India Students Association(AISA), Forum for Federal India, Progressive Democratic Students Union(PDSU), South Asian Forum for People's Initiatives, JNU Forum Against War on People, Democratic Students Union(DSU), Students for Resistance(SFR), Coordination Committee for Oppressed Nationalities(CCON), Naga Study Forum, Committee for the Release of Political Prisoners (CRPP), Students' League, Campus Front of India, The New Materialists(TNM), Popular Front of India, Forum For Freedom, Forum for People's Right, All India Students Federation (AISF), Pakistan-India People's Forum for Peace and Democracy, Feminist Collective, Revolutionary Cultural Front, People's Alliance for the Repeal of AFPSA, Delhi Tamil Students Union, Centre for Policy Analysis (Prof. Anuradha Chenoy) etc. have been floated and operated from JNU campus. Prof. Kamal Mitra Chenoy, Prof. Anuradha Chenoy, Prof. Ayesha Kidwai, Prof. Nivedita Menon, Prof. A. K. Ramakrishnan, Prof. Madhu Sahni, who indulge in such activities at the behest of hostile foreign agencies, are the main brain behind these activities. They have become Frankstein monster in the JNU campus as they have created a sort of terrorizing influence over the silent majority of teachers and students.
4. On 15 November 1995 the South Asian Forum for People's Initiative organized a symposium at JNU on Kashmir. Azam Inquilabi, a well known terrorist and self styled Chief of Operation Balakot used the JNU platform to advocate secession of Kashmir. (A copy of the proceedings of this symposium as was published in *Kashmir Sentinel* on 16-31 January 1996 is enclosed). The guest speakers included Kashmiri terrorists who stayed at JNU Aravali guest house.
5. PDSU, which operated from Sabarmati Hostel, JNU organized on 6 February 1996 another seminar on Kashmir to coincide with state sponsored strike in Pakistan in support of Kashmiri terrorists. This seminar was addressed by known India-baiters. A sustained, well orchestrated and virulent propaganda was thus unleashed in JNU against India. Prof. Badal Ghana Chakravorty of Centre for German Studies, JNU who raised this issue in his signed letter to Registrar of JNU on 7-2-1996 later left JNU campus as a very disillusioned person. (copy enclosed)

6. One Mohammad Naim Ullah, Secretary General of Mohammed Abdus Salam Foundation, London stayed in and operated from JNU Campus in October 1996 ostensibly to open a branch of this Foundation in October 1996, but actually to disburse Rs. 800 million to influence the Muslim voters in assembly elections in Uttar Pradesh. He was working on behalf of Pakistani agencies. (Copy of his letter dated 25 October 1996 is enclosed.)
7. On 29 April 2000 an Indo-Pak *Mushaira* was organized in JNU campus, ostensibly as a poetic event, but actually to malign and belittle Indian victory in the Kargil war of 1999. Two army majors (in civilian dress) who were visiting their friends in JNU were witness to such pro-Pakistan slogans. The two army majors, who had just fought in the Kargil heights against Pakistan reacted to such slogans and got beaten up by the student's mob instigated by anti-national elements in JNU. The issue became a major controversy, but was hushed up.
8. Soon after the hijacking of Indian Airlines plane to Kandhar in December 1999 by the Pak terrorists, Prof. Anuradha Chenoy of JNU publicly accused Indian agencies of organizing this hijacking in order to defame Pakistan internationally. Her Zee TV interview/clip was telecast repeatedly by Pakistan to put India in a tight spot. Prof. Chenoy has been an open and virulent supporter of Pakistan sponsored terrorists in Kashmir. She has participated in G. N. Fai's seminars in USA and Muzaffarabad (POK).
9. Prof. Anuradha Chenoy, Prof. Kamal Chenoy (both of JNU), Gautam Navlakha, Achin Vinnai, Rita Manchanda, Teesta Setelvad have been the kingpins of the Pak sponsored activities against India related to Kashmir, North-East, Naxals etc.
10. Naga Study Forum has been organizing several meetings to project the activities of the National Socialist Council of Nagalim (NSCN) which has been fighting for a sovereign Nagaland after its secession from India. (See the Posters of Naga Study Forum in JNU for ready reference).
11. Democratic Students Union (DSU) which is spearheaded and funded by Pakistan through Prof. Ayesha Kidwai and Prof. Anuradha Chenoy (of JNU) has been since 2007 in the forefront of undermining Indian sovereignty over Kashmir, legitimizing secessionist movements in Kashmir and the North-East,

repeal of AFPSA, defaming India by exaggerating Indian atrocities in Kashmir and North-East, raising the issue of mass graves and disappearances in Kashmir. The main slogan of DSU is *Azadi* (independence) for Kashmir, *Ladke lenge Azadi*. (Please see the posters/statements of DSU littered through JNU campus and also some clips of their speeches, demonstrations etc). Prof. Amitabh Kundu, a senior professor of JNU filed a complaint with the Superintendent of Police, Crime Branch, CGOI Complex, New Delhi on 31-1-2014 asking for urgent enquiry into the activities of DSU. (Copy of his complaint and the acknowledgment of Joint Commr. of Police, Crime Branch, Mandir Marg, New Delhi dated 31-1-2014 are enclosed for ready reference).

12. On 5 March 2011, Arundhati Roy and Prof. Amit Bhaduri of JNU addressed a meeting *Operation Green Hunt* in JNU organized by JNU Forum against War on People, in which national emblem was publicly trampled under the boot. This matter was also raised in Rajya Sabha on 9 March 2011. DSU also uses 3 pigs in place of three lions of the national emblem in its posters throughout the JNU campus. (copies of the posters denigrating the national emblem and the MP's question in Rajya Sabha are enclosed for ready reference).
13. When JNU Forum against War on People was banned from organizing any activities in the JNU campus, Prof. Kamal Mitra Chenoy, Prof. Anuradha Chenoy and Prof. Ayesha Kidwai sat on dharna/hunger strike before the JNU administrative block disrupting normal work of the University, in protest against such ban. And now this Forum has started its activities again. This Forum publicly organised a dance party/revelry in front of Godavari dhaba to celebrate the massacre of 76 CRPF jawans in Dhantewada in 2011.
14. Indian national flag and national emblem are being routinely trampled and denigrated in the JNU Campus (Copies of posters enclosed). On 25 August 2011 some students tore the national flag in Tapti hostel, with the JNU administration being a mute spectator. The case is still lingering in Vasant Vihar police station. Besides, a poster of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose celebrating Netaji's Jayanti on 23 January 2014 was torn apart. (copy of the torn poster enclosed).
15. Of late the focus of DSU, AISA etc. has been to highlight the cause of *Azadi* (independence) for Kashmir, mass graves and enforced disappearances,

martyrdom of Maqbool Bhat and Afzal Guru. Recently on 9 February 2014 a huge *Masha* procession was organized in JNU campus in the evening by Prof. Ayesha Kidwai, Prof. Anuradha Chenoy and Prof. Kamal Mitra Chenoy through their front organizations (DSU, AISA). These three faculty members have recruited over a hundred students (for instance Ms. Deepti Tamang, Ms. Priyadarshini, Rauf, Umar Khalid, Iqbal Majeed Bhat, Dawa Sherpa, Rona Wilson, Syed Mohammad Raqib, Shehla Rashid Shora, Bano Jyotsna Lahiri, Ashutosh, Rajan Jha are the most vocal slogan raisers) and activists by feeding them with funds, alcohol and other facilities like placements in various NGOs, civil society groups, institutes that are run in India with the funding of Ford Foundation, foreign agencies, Action Aid, Oxfam etc. Angana Chatterjee (who visited Kashmir and prepared a report on Mass Graves and Enforced Disappearances at the behest of Pakistan and who was later deported from Kashmir by the Government of India), Ghulam Nabi Fai (who was arrested by the FBI, USA for using Pak funds), Gautam Navlakha, Arundhati Roy, S. A. R. Geelani, Parvez Imroz, Mrs. Parveena Ahangar, Mr. Showkat Hussan --all known Kashmiri separatists, Teesta Setelvad and other known anti-India activists have been working along with Prof. Kamal Chenoy, Prof. Anuradha Chenoy, Prof. Nivedita Menon and Prof. Ayesha Kidwai in such misdemeanours. They have been signatories to a petition to President of India against the execution of Afzal Guru. (Copy of the petition is enclosed for ready reference). Copies of statements of Prof. Kamal Chenoy and Prof. Anuradha Chenoy demanding self-determination for Kashmiris in their speeches at the conferences organized by Ghulam Nabi Fai in USA and Muzaffarabad (POK) are also enclosed for ready reference.

It is clear beyond doubt (on the basis of enclosed documentary evidence) that a few academics of JNU particularly Prof. Ayesha Kidwai, Prof. Kamal Mitra Chenoy, Prof. Anuradha Chenoy, Prof. Nivedita Menon have been misusing the JNU and their coveted position of senior teachers in the University for propagating secessionism in Kashmir and North-East, legitimizing and rationalizing terrorist activities in these states, stoking the fires of hate and anti-national sentiments by organizing seminars, lectures, issuing pamphlets, posters, publications and *nukkad nataks*, rallies, demonstrations, sit ins, hunger strikes and strikes in JNU for several years

without any fear. In fact the string of anti-India activities in international fora including the UN Human Rights Council, European Parliament, US Congress, UK House of Commons and by foreign NGOs particularly Amnesty International, Freedom House etc. is closely tied to these JNU dons who actually provide the base materials for their foreign mentors. The main goal of their activities is to attack Indian sovereignty in Kashmir, North-East, keep the Indian state in a destabilised state through Naxal, Maoist violence, secessionist movements. They are actively recruiting young minds in JNU campus and elsewhere by addicting them to night parties/revelries, alcoholism and cash payments to carry forward their agenda through mass campaigns, strikes etc. They also ensure that their young M.Phil/PhD students are placed in comfortable jobs in institutions like IDSA, Indian Council of World Affairs, National Security Council Secretariat, NTRO, Universities, think tanks and NGOs to propagate their ideology of hate, secessionism and terrorism in the mask of liberalism, democracy and freedom.

The Government of India and its agencies particularly the Intelligence Bureau, RAW, Enforcement Directorate need to hold a time bound enquiry into the nefarious and seditious activities of these few JNU academics. Pending such enquiry, these persons (Prof. Kamal Mitra Chenoy, Prof. Anuradha Chenoy, Prof. Ayesha Kidwai, and Prof. Nivedita Menon) be immediately suspended from the service of JNU and their passports be seized. These few persons who have polluted the work culture of big institutions like JNU need to be arrested and punished under law. Besides, the national institutions like Indian Council of Social Research, Indian Council of Historical Research, Institute for Defense Studies and Analyses, Indian Council of World Affairs, NTRO, Teen Murti, Delhi University etc. be cleansed and purged of these anti-national and secessionist elements.
