We criticize unequivocally the comments made by Gyandev Ahuja. We are appalled, ashamed, shocked and infuriated when an elected representative uses such crude, regressive, abusive, fouled language against the Students of JNU. We demand that he must himself resign from his post. No one has the right to malign and defame JNU as a university. We cannot let anyone do character assassination of University or perform moral policing of such nature.

The night of 23rd February, 2016 will be a watershed moment in JNU's History. Our proposition that "Left's (AISA, SFI, AISF, DSF and DSU) dedication towards principles is a case of Empty symbolism, vacuous rhetoric, and cosmetic gestures" proved correct. 'Rhetoric of Revolution' was to wangle vote. Rap of revolution was sham.
